Re: Demand note to unfreeze immediately Polish American Congress - NCD and its Polonia Foundation accounts at the Polam FCU.

Once again, as the current President of the Polish American Congress - Northern California Division (PAC-NCD), I demand that the Polam FCU Board of Directors unfreezes effective immediately the PAC-NCD and its Polonia Foundation accounts at the Polam FCU and provide unrestricted access to the deposited in this accounts funds for the current PAC-NCD Treasurer, Mrs. Zofia Shicker and President, Mr. Anthony Zukovsky.

Mr. Zdzislaw Zakrzewski - Polam's BoD Secretary was notified on October 20, 2006 by the Polish American Congress National Office Grievance Committee that he was not elected as he himself proclaimed to be a new President of the PAC-NCD on July 9, 2006. This was stated by the Grievance Committee on page 2 of their Report at Finding #4: *" That the alleged election held on July 9, 2006 of the PAC-Northern California Division was not valid."*

In result of this PAC Grievance Committee ruling, Mr. Zdzislaw Zakrzewski and other Polam's Board Members like Mrs. Zofia Zakrzewska, Mr. Andrzej Szafranski, Mr. Jacek Wagner have had no any legal rights to block access to the PAC-NCD and its Polonia Foundation accounts at the Polam FCU for the current PAC-NCD President and Treasurer.

The illegal freezing of the PAC-NCD accounts have caused a financial hardship to the PAC, curtailment of its activities and injured also the Polish American Community at large. Traditional cultural events staged each year like the Polish Festival celebrating Polish Heritage month which was planned for October 2006 was for the first time ever canceled due to lack of access to the frozen funds at the Polam. The PAC-NCD &

Polonia Foundation lost \$5,000 in possible income from this Festival. The coming Polish Spring Festival, planned for May this year, may also be canceled, if access to our funds at Polam is not immediately unblocked.

The PAC-NCD intends to take legal action against the Polam FCU to restore access to our funds deposited at Polam FCU and also to recover the losses.
